Guest speaker: Louis Porter Commissioner of Fish & Wildlife

Commissioner Porter gave a verbal update on his proposed items for submission to Governor Scott and commissioners involved to be submitted to legislature for approval. The proposals are as follows and much discussion was had at the meeting, mostly agreeing with his proposals with minor tweaking suggestions.

- 1). Trail decals for usage on all VASA trails and town lands.
- 2). Drivers licenses are not required to operate ATV's, but if you lose drivers license you will not be allowed to operate ATV's on roads.
 - 3). Helmet and insurance to be required.
- 4). At this time, the state has a [no pursuit policy regarding ATV's], would like to have numerous check points set up.
 - 5). ATV limited ATV usage on state lands.
 - 6). ATV's to be required to have brake lights.
 - 7). Mufflers to be stock, no modified mufflers.
 - 8). 25 MPH speed limit unless posted for less.
 - 9). Penalties to be higher for violations.
- 10). Safety course required for all, on an established born after date.
- 11). Farm plates to be issued for farm use only.

1). Web Site:

a) Membership is at 3026 at this time.
