VASA TRAIL SIGN GUIDELINES

POLICY:

VASA TRAIL SIGNAGE GUIDELINES

PURPOSE:

TO ESTABLISH CLEAR GUIDELINES AND EXPECTATIONS FOR THE DISTRIBUTION AND POSTING OF VASA SIGNS.

SIGNAGE DIMENSIONS GUIDELINES:

HEIGHT: THIRTY SIX (36) INCHES TO FIFTY (50) INCHES TOP OF SIGN.

VASA SIGNS SHOULD BE AT ALL TRAIL INTERSECTIONS, AND AT ALL SUITABLE AND NECESSARY LOCATIONS WITH LANDOWNER PERMISSION.

METHOD:

SIGNS SHOULD BE SECURELY FASTENED TO A FREE STANDING POST A MINIMUM OF (60) SIXTY INCHES. VASA SIGNS SHOULD NEVER BE NAILED OR SCREWED TO TREES. ANY CLUB ALTERED SIGNS SHOULD BE MARKED IN A CLEAR AND TASTEFUL MANNER.

SIGNS SHOULD BE PROPERLY MAINTAINED AND TRIMMED AROUND FOR MAXIMUM VISIBILITY. TRAIL SIGNAGE SHOULD BE DONE WITH MINIMUM AMOUNT OF SIGNS, NOT MAXIMUM.

OBTAINING VASA SIGNS:

VASA SIGNS ARE AVAILABLE AT THE VASA OFFICE OR BOARD OF DIRECTOR MEETINGS WHEN A SIGN REQUEST FORM HAS BEEN PRESENTED A MINIMUM OF SEVEN (7) DAYS BEFOREHAND.

SIGNS ARE BROKEN INTO TWO CATEGORIES:

STANDARD SIGNS ARE SIGNS REQUIRED TO SAFETY NAVIGATE VASA TRAILS. THESE SIGNS WILL BE FUNDED AT 50% CLUB - 50% VASA COST SHARE

OPTIONAL SIGNS ARE ALL OTHERS THAT PROVIDE GUIDANCE AND INFO. THESE WILL BE FUNDED 100% CLUB FUNDS

attached D). The Clubs will absorb ½ the cost. TOW was assigned CA 76 thru CA 100. The first 2 letters (CA) represent the county. If more numbers are needed, more will be assigned by VASA at the request of each club. The placement needs to be documented on a map so they can be added to the map for next years TMA Sales.
