1). Town Ordinances:

- a) VASA staff is working on hiring a younger person to assist with the on line registrations and misc. office duties.
- b) At present VASA has three new club, bring to a total of 21.

- b) Two grants awarded this year (safety program) & (Bennington club, Wofford).

9) Act 250:

a) Act 250 is 50 years old and will be updated.
