Lunenburg four wheeler ordinance

- 1. All ATV's operating on Lunenburg town highways or under this ordinance are subject to and must abide by all state of Vermont ATV and motor vehicle laws.
- 2. The Town of Lunenburg accepts and utilizes the VSA title definition of ATV's and it is those vehicles that are subject to this ordinance.
- 3. All ATV's operating on town highways shall not spin, brake, accelerate or drive and ATV in such a manner as to alter the state of the surface of the road by disrupting dirt or gravel and creating ruts or divits on the roadway.
- * 4. Person 16 years of age and older operating ATV's on town highways must possess a valid drivers license and a valid training certificate. Unlicensed operators under keyears of age must possess a valid training certificate. and be operating with a licensed operator 18 years of age or older. and operating with a licensed operator.

 All ridors must ride single file and ohev nosted speed limits

 18 years of older
 - 5. All riders must ride single file and obey posted speed limits
 - 6. Helmets must be worn by all riders 18 and under.
 - 7. All machines must be registered and carry insurance unless on private property with written permission.
 - 8. No one is allowed to operate under the age of 18 without a training certificate, unless on their own property.
 - 9. Violators will be subject to fines.

Fines will be assessed at \$100.00 for each violation of the ordinance as follows

- 1. No helmet
- 2. Speed in excess of limit
- 3. Operations w/out a license or training certificate
- 4. Operations w/out insurance
- 5. Disrupting road surfaces
