VASA Report: November & December

- 5) State of Vt. Looking into possible Landowner appreciation day.
- 6) Landowner permission slips (policy change) to be voted on at the July meeting.

 - B) Add landowner permission signature before any trailwork to be done.
- 7) TAD's for 2026, board members to vote on an increase of \$5.00 for the club and \$5.00 for VASA.
- 8) Club Tax updates – all clubs are good with IRS & SOS.
- 9) Incident at Williamstown (landowner pointed gun at two offenders). VASA to issue a put-on notice, membership may be revoked. Waiting on the state police report. (State Police dropped the case, local club to try and resolve locally before VASA takes further action)

Old Business:

- a) Bombard road and bridge have been taken care of, Temple Hill is now passable by ATV.
- b) TOW has donated \$100.00 to the 8th grade class.

New Business:

- a) Lunenburg to repair the West Thomas Road, TOW to put up signs (work in progress).
- b) Lunenburg is starting their own ATV club. (James Sullivan is waiting for a return call from Ethan Hill. Steve to email Etan a reminder to contact James).
- c) TOW to sell the Honda tractor for \$3,500.00.
- d) RJ to start conversation with Great River Hydro regarding establishing a trail loop in Waterford.
- e) TOW to rent an excavator to repair trails and eliminate water holes at trail from Carr Brook to Horn of the Moon.
- f) Chad to have stone dropped at bridges and Carr Brook.
- g) Moose River snow machine club has grant to fix trail from bridges to power line.

A motion was made by RJ and seconded by Steve to adjourn, unanimously approved by vote. Meeting adjourned at 9:51 am.
