It was agreed to stockpile stone for trail work. Also, a trail to be established around the camp and a gate installed.]
- 5) Chad to have stone dropped at bridges and Carr Brook. (next year). [No change]
- 6) Mike Brown to start next week the trail from Ladd Road to Streeter Road. [No change]
- 7) Johnson Road issue: Road gated at the end of the road, town & neighbor to look into legality. Is the road a trail or what classification is the road. [Chad discussed with owner the idea of posting closed during hunting season and opened the rest of the season. Post signage early for riders to get accustomed to seeing.]
